



2023 - 24 COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP RULES & APPLICATION

Eligibility for the Altamaha Federal Credit Union 2023 - 24 College Scholarship is as follows:

- Student must be a current member of Altamaha FCU and must have been a member since May 1, 2023. Membership must show the student as the primary accountholder and must show the account as being in good standing.
- Student must be currently enrolled as a senior eligible for graduation during the 2023 - 24 school year at a high school in Wayne or Long counties.
- Student must have a cumulative GPA equivalent to a "B" or higher during his or her high school career.
- Student must have been accepted by an accredited college or university and present a letter of acceptance from said college or university.
- Student must graduate and enroll in the fall semester at an accredited college or university. As funds are paid directly to the college or university, student must provide any change made to his school of enrollment and the school listed on the acceptance letter to Altamaha FCU.
- Student must maintain a cumulative GPA equivalent to a "B" or higher once enrolled in college. Proof of such should be submitted to Altamaha FCU prior to the second semester to be eligible for second semester payment.
- Student must submit completed application with high school transcript supporting GPA requirement listed above by the close of business on Thursday, April 11, 2024.

Altamaha FCU will award three scholarships for the 2024 - 25 college year, one of which will be to a student of a Long County high school and two to students of a Wayne County high school. Recipients are chosen through a random drawing of all eligible applicants and will be announced at the honors program for graduation at the recipients' respective schools. The total scholarship amount is \$2,500.00 per student and is disbursed in two installments of \$1,250.00 to coincide with each semester of the student's freshman college year. Each installment will be paid directly to the college in which the student has enrolled. No payment, directly or indirectly, may be made to the student.
